Nature Challenge Leaf bowl craft

Then put cling film over the top of the leaves and put the second bowl on top to hold the leaves in place.

After a few days drying in a warm place, remove the bowl and cling film, and you'll be left with a beautiful leaf bowl.

Draw a map of your garden. Don't forget to include a key! Then use your map to direct someone around your garden using: - North, South, East and West - Forwards, Backwards, left and right.



Art challenge Rainbow Shaving foam art.




Wellbeing Challenge Smile challenge
