Here is **list 3**, the next set of 10 spellings to tackle.

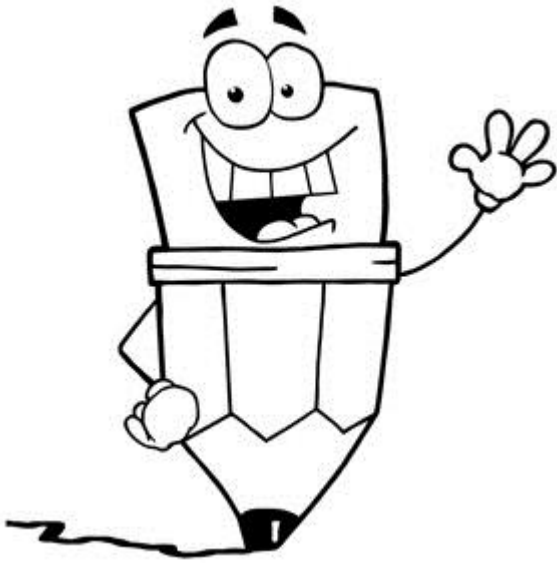
Please follow the same advice detailed in the Spelling Support Introduction and have fun.

This week it is time to return to previous spellings and check that they are still being spelled correctly. We do this by playing **Spelling Bingo** and the instructions have been added to our page. Children love this game, so please try it.

We have also added the words **off** and **of** in this list, as children struggle to use them correctly.

When children hear the word of, they spell it like this - 'ov' because of the sound it makes. Try using the word cards included to reinforce the difference in the spelling, alongside the difference in the way the word is heard and said. Practise saying sentences and ask the children to hold up the correct card.
