LO: To solve addition problems involving up to 4-digit numbers.

A family needs 1,234 kilograms of snow for their snowman, 872 kilograms of snow for their snow fort, and 1,096 kilograms of snow for their snowball fight. How much snow do they need in total?



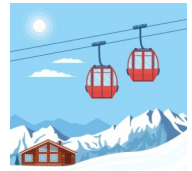
During a winter sports festival, 1,560 people attended the ice skating competition, 2,342 people attended the tobogganing event, and 1,125 people attended the snowboarding contest. How many people attended all three events combined?



Sarah spent £859 on gifts for her family, £1,045 on decorations for her home, and £320 on holiday treats. What is the total amount Sarah spent?



In one day, 734 ski lift tickets were sold in the morning, 1,205 tickets were sold in the afternoon, and 984 tickets were sold in the evening. How many ski lift tickets were sold that day in total?



A winter charity appeal collected 1,420 warm coats, 765 pairs of wellies, and 1,125 pairs of gloves. How many winter clothing items were collected in total?



Over the course of a week, it snowed 254 centimetres on Monday, 317 centimetres on Tuesday, 281 centimetres on Wednesday, 398 centimetres on Thursday, and 215 centimetres on Friday. What is the total amount of snow that fell during the week?
