

<p><u>Living Things and their Habitats</u> As scientists the children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> explore and use classification keys. recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways. recognise that environments can be changed and that this can sometimes pose dangers to specific habitats. <p><u>Animals</u> As scientists the children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans. identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions. construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, prey and predators. 	<p>As geographers we will consolidate atlas skills by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Locate the world’s countries focusing on South America Use maps, atlases, globes, and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied Identify the position and significance of Equator, the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn, Northern and Southern Hemispheres Describe key aspects of physical geography including climate zones and biomes and human geography including distribution of natural resources, land use and economic activity. 	<p><u>Hockey: Unit focus-</u> Consistently perform basic Hockey skills such as dribbling and push passes.
