Capital letters are used for:

Beginning sentences:

The old lady took her dog for a walk..

Peoples names:

Charlie Smith, Curly, Mrs Black, Mr Jones, Miss Smart.

Names of places:

England, New York, River Thames, Redditch.

Names of streets, roads and buildings:

Feckenham Road, Buckingham Palace, Church Street.

Days, months and special days:

Tuesday, January, Christmas, Easter.

Title of books, plays, songs, newspapers, films and poems:

The Spy Who Loved Me, The Daily Mail, Harry Potter and The Philosopher's Stone.

The word I is always a capital letter:

I think I am going to be sick!
