Capital letters are used for:

<u>Beginning sentences:</u> The old lady took her dog for a walk..

<u>Peoples names:</u> Charlie Smith, Curly, Mrs Black, Mr Jones, Miss Smart.

<u>Names of places:</u> England, New York, River Thames, Redditch.

<u>Names of streets, roads and buildings:</u> Feckenham Road, Buckingham Palace, Church Street.

<u>Days, months and special days:</u> Tuesday, January, Christmas, Easter.

<u>Title of books, plays, songs, newspapers, films and poems:</u>

The Spy Who Loved Me, The Daily Mail, Harry Potter and The Philosopher's Stone.

The word I is always a capital letter: I think I am going to be sick!
