Dear Parents and Carers,

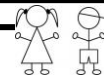

If you do not have internet access, please call 01905 822700 for assistance.

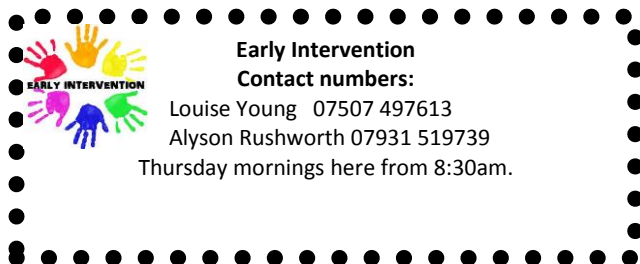
The closing date for both first and middle school places is 15th January 2020

REMINDER

Absence from school must be reported via the absence telephone line, the MYED app or phoning into the school office on a daily basis, otherwise the absence will be unauthorised. The school office must be informed of any medical appointments before the day or on the day with evidence of the appointment provided in order for it to be authorised. All other reasons for absence including holidays during term time we request you complete a leave of absence form available from the school office.
