

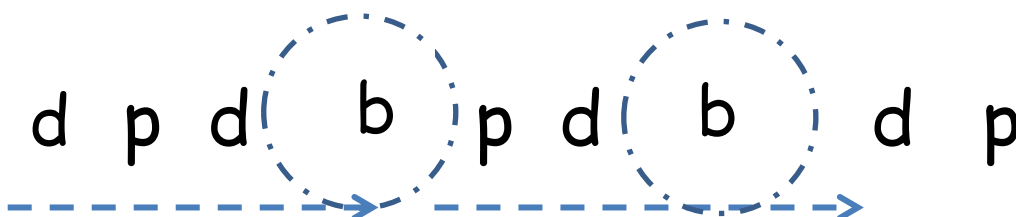
# Tracking

Tracking is a really useful activity. It can improve L - R reading, careful following of text without losing your place and scanning for key information.

## Instructions

Start with the pencil at the beginning of the line. Draw a line under the text and circle any word or letter that is being tracked, in an anticlockwise direction. Keep the pencil on the paper and continue until you have reached the end of the line. Only then remove the pencil, to begin the next new line.

Track the letter **u** in this row of letters.
