Dear Parents and Carers,

There has been a real buzz around school during the last 2 weeks as the Autumn term got well underway. All the year groups have been working hard and making a great start to their learning.

In Reception and Year 1, the children have really taken to their 'Little Wandle' phonic lessons and have been enjoying the new reading books that they are bringing home to read to you. I hope you have enjoyed listening and sharing the books with them. Children in Year 2 have been finding out about Queen Victoria and how King Charles III is related to her as they started their learning about the Victorians. In Year 3 the children have been learning to count in French. They have learned the numbers up to 10 whilst playing bingo and singing! Year 4 have been solving a historical puzzle about the start of WW2 using their skills as historians to draw conclusions and as scientists they've been investigating electricity.

In assemblies we have been focusing on our core value of 'Kindness' and have had our first celebration assemblies to acknowledge those children who have displayed our learning 'Superpowers'.
